

Attire Requirements – Commencement

****Please note:** The cap and gown for the 2019 Graduation DOES NOT MATCH color/material of gowns prior to 2018. Graduates MUST wear the cap and gown from Jostens.

The following is to be worn for Graduation on June 5th. You DO NOT need to wear cap and gown to the Rehearsal, the Awards Assembly, or the Scholarship Night.

NO SENIORS CAN WALK ACROSS THE STAGE WITHOUT CAP AND GOWN AND PROPER ATTIRE!!!

Males: Pastel or white shirt, dark tie, dark or khaki pants (NO JEANS), dark socks and shoes, (NO TENNIS SHOES OR SANDALS), a well-pressed gown and a squared hat. Tassel on right.

Females: Neutral colored shoes, (NO TENNIS SHOES), white/light-colored clothing (any color or pattern is visible under the gown), a well-pressed gown, and a squared hat. Tassel on right.

Honor cords: Members of honor societies will wear cords provided by the school to honor these seniors. Recipients of scholastic medals will likewise be able to wear them during the ceremony. Only cords and medals awarded through the school will be allowed.

Please Note: - Seniors will not be permitted to graduate on stage with the class if one or more of the following conditions apply:

- Financial obligations to the school are not paid (including but not limited to: transcript fees, library fines, parking tickets, unreturned textbooks and uniforms)
- Failure to attend the scheduled rehearsal Thursday May 23rd, 8am in the gymnasium
- Failure to arrive with the proper attire including cap and gown.

In-School Awards Assembly – Scholarship Night

Dress: For the In-School Assembly, rule of thumb is just look nice. The Scholarship Night is a dressier occasion and business casual dress should be followed. Honors cords and medals awarded through the school may be worn to both events.
