## **Student Arrival/Departure**

Buses will drop students off at the auditorium entrance. All bus riding students are expected to wait in the auditorium until 7:30 AM when they are dismissed to go to their lockers and Homeroom.

Parents who drive their students to school should drive around the back of the building and drop their student off at the cafeteria entrance under the Science Building bridge. Please stay to the right side of the driveway, as cars may pass you on the left side while you are dropping off your student. I would recommend that your student sit on the passenger side of the car so they can quickly exit the car without opening their door into passing traffic.

Students who are driving to school must have a parking permit and park in their assigned numbered parking spot in their assigned lot. Their hangtag must be visible in their vehicle at all times. Students driving around the back of the building to get to the Lower Lot should drive in the left lane when going under the Science Building bridge.
